SERIES THEME SCRIPTURE Exodus 20:8-11

Remember the sabbath day, and keep it holy. For six days you shall labor and do all your work. 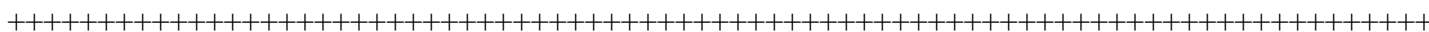
*1. What a friend we have in Jesus,
